
Scott also served his country as a member of the U.S. Army. Scott retired in August of 2018, having served the Army for twenty-one years.

The Payne family's plan is to continue to serve the Lord by reaching the U.S. military by opening a Military Serviceman's Center to care for their physical and spiritual needs.


